# JOIN LARRY KIRWAN AS HE PLAYS ON A TOUR OF IRELAND

#### **Daily Itinerary**

Day 1, October 6 – Friday: USA – Ireland Overnight flight from the US to Dublin Ireland.

**Day 2, October 7 – Saturday: Dublin – Belfast.** After clearing customs, travelers and those already in Ireland are united and met by your professional Irish Driver Guide and Hammond Tours Group Escort. **The Tour starts at Dublin Airport at 10am.** Leaving Dublin we begin our adventures by driving north past the site of the **Battle of the Boyne** (1690), where William of Orange defeated King James and set the tone for Irish politics for the next 300 years. Even at the height of the Troubles, Belfast was renowned for its humor and hospitality. Almost 30 years after the initiation of the **Peace Process** the city is booming, zestful, and full of new purpose. We'll stop for lunch at one of my favorite places, An Cultúrlann, a bookshop, café, theatre in the heart of the Belfast Gaeltacht where you can try your Irish phrases with native speakers. We'll take the *Coiste* Tour of the Falls Road and Shankill Road guided by former combatants - always a revelatory experience – and view the political murals and the much-decorated Peace Wall. Then it's off to the Europa Hotel where we'll get to know each other over a **welcome dinner**. Later we'll cross the street and visit the Victorian style **Crown Liquor Saloon**, one of the most renowned pubs in Europe. **Dinner & Overnight Europa Hotel Belfast** 

#### Day 3, October 8 - Sunday: Belfast

After a full Irish breakfast, we'll head north along the Coast Road and through the lovely **Glens of Antrim**. We'll travel along the spectacular coastline up to the **Giant's Causeway** and its 40,000 interlocking basalt columns that form the legendary causeway built by the Irish giant *Fionn mac Cumhail* (Finn MacCool). We'll then journey through some of the areas where **Game of Thrones** was filmed. It's easy to see why location scouts chose the North of Ireland, with its rugged coastlines, lush green fields, caves, mountains, forests, and cliffs, as the setting for George RR Martin's fantasy world. Then back to Belfast for a night on the town. During our stay we'll meet former **Lord Mayor Mairtín Ó'Muilleoir**, writers, activists and other figures from across the political divide. That's Belfast for you, a city that came through so much, and has reinvented itself as a dynamic symbol for hope and change. Our Hotel Europa neighborhood has many interesting bars and shops, and

after the obligatory stop at The Crown, I suggest you try out the nearby Duke of York and Kelly's Cellars. **Overnight at the Europa Hotel Belfast**

#### Day 4, October 9 – Monday: Belfast – Wexford.

Leaving Belfast we'll head south on our longest journey that will take us to my hometown of Wexford. We'll skirt the city of Dublin this time and make for the Wicklow Mountains. On our way we'll show one of the documentaries about Black 47. Remember that these tours of Ireland began when fans of the band would follow us on our annual musical tours of Ireland. You'll hear B47's original music, interviews and live shows, and see how the band introduced Irish history and politics into Rock 'n' Roll. We'll stop for a break at the Avoca Mill, Café, and visitor center. The weaving mill itself was founded in 1723. Try the scones in the cafe!! And then on to Wexford and the beginning of our two-day South-East Medieval Tour! Wexford was founded by the Vikings and later became a walled medieval town; the streets breathe history. Henry II did penance in Selskar Abbey in 1172 for the murder of St. Thomas a Beckett. Oliver Cromwell slaughtered women and children in the Bull Ring after a traitor opened the West Gate. Much of this history will be dealt with on an evening tour of the old town led by actor and historian Paul Walsh as he winds his dramatic way through Viking lanes, medieval graveyards, Norman walls and ancient town gates. Later that evening get your first taste of Wexford pubs, renowned for their hospitality. Some that I recommend close to the hotel are Mary's Bar, Thomas Moore Tavern, Macken's Bar and Undertakers, and my parents' old haunt, Simon's on the Main Street. Overnight at the Clayton Wexford Hotel.

#### Day 5, October 10 - Tuesday: Wexford- Kilkenny- Wexford.

My advice - get up early and take a walk along Wexford's beautiful Quayside and watch the sun rise over the Slaney River as it flows into the harbor. Then we're off on the 2nd day of our medieval mini-tour to Kilkenny. This small city is delightful and when you have a free moment visit legendary Kytler's Inn. But Kilkenny Castle is the main attraction. Founded soon after the Norman Invasion of 1169 it has been extended, and adapted for over 800 years. Walk through its 50 acres of rolling parkland. But don't miss the bus because we'll be heading for the wild Wexford coastline and will make a stop at **Hook Head** and the oldest operational lighthouse in the world. And yes, the phrase "by hook or by crook" came from here. Then back home along the coast where I'll give a concert in the Wexford Arts Centre. Though recently added to and refurbished there'll be ghosts aplenty present for it's where I began my music career playing to teddyboys, mods and rockers who liked nothing better than to rumble it up during the dances. The after-party will be around the corner in Mary's Bar where you'll meet my family and old friends (don't believe any of their stories). Overnight at the Clayton Wexford Hotel.

#### Day 6, October 11- Wednesday. Wexford- Dublin.

After breakfast we make our way north to Dublin. Once in Dublin you will have the option of taking a **1916 Insurrection tour.** The Easter Rising of 1916 was the most dramatic event in the history of Ireland's struggle for independence from the British Empire. The executions of the leaders after the Rising awakened a generation to the cause of Irish freedom, resulting in the War of Independence, the formation of the Irish Free State and as a result the Irish Civil War. Then enjoy a night on the town! Take in a play at The Abbey Theatre or a rock concert at Whelan's. Dublin's pubs are famous the world over, some of my favorites are Neary's, Davy Byrne's, McDaid's all close by our hotel. For Irish Traditional Music don't miss The Cobblestone, O'Donoghue's (where The Dubliners began), The Palace Bar, The Brazen Head, The Temple Bar Pub, The Celt. Or just follow your nose. It's hard to go wrong. **Overnight at Camden Court Dublin.** 

#### Day 7, October 12, Thursday: Dublin.

On our last full day in Dublin, I suggest that you consider visiting Kilmainham Gaol Museum. This is a moving experience that will take you through much of Ireland's complex and turbulent history. But do book online well before you leave for Ireland, as the jail is a very popular destination. Today is a free day and we'll provide you with day passes for the Hop-On Hop-Off Bus Tours of Dublin. Just go where you will but there are trips offered to Kilmainham Jail, Guinness Storehouse, Book of Kells - Trinity College, National Museum of Ireland, National Gallery, etc. But do spend some time in some of Dublin's beautiful parks, St. Stephen's Green, Merrion Square or Phoenix Park, and for a big treat why not have afternoon tea in the Lord Mayor's Room at The Shelbourne Hotel (reservations & jackets needed). Regardless, come back to the Camden Court in time for our farewell dinner, after which we shall all repair next door to The Bleeding Horse for our celebratory American Wake. Dinner and Overnight at Camden Court Dublin.

#### Day 8, October 13, Friday: Dublin – USA

Those of us traveling back to the USA will be transported by bus to **Dublin Airport** where we'll say goodbye to our Irish Driver Guide and Hammond Tours Group Escort. There will be time for some last-minute duty-free shopping and, perhaps, a last pint of Guinness. This is merely a sketch of what you'll see and do. I can't even begin to describe the long nights of fun and laughter that will leave you with warm memories and **friends for life**. But I do promise that this trip to Ireland will nourish your soul and quite possibly change your life!
