Today's adventure involves a half-hour jaunt into County Offaly to the ruins of St Ciarán's 6 th -century of <i>Clonmacnoise</i> (from <i>Cluain Mhic Nóis</i> , "the meadow of the sons of Nós") on the east bank of the River Shannon as once crossed by <i>Slighe Mhór</i> . The ruins include a cathedral, seven churches, two round towers, three high crosses and a ction of early-Christian grave slabs. It's strategic location on "the Great Highway" helped it become a major center of arning, craftsmanship, and trade by the 9 th -century. It was one of the most famous places in Ireland, visited by scholars er Europe, and many of the high kings of Tara and Connacht were buried here.
