Day 1, March 27: Friday: Shannon Airport- Dingle.

Morning arrival at Shannon Airport where you are greeted by your Driver/Guide. The group will depart the airport at 10:00AM. We first will make our way to a venue for breakfast. We then make our way to Limerick where we will tour King John's Castle. King John's Castle is a 13th-century fortress located in Limerick, Ireland, overlooking the River Shannon. Built on the orders of King John of England, the castle features massive stone walls, towers, and a well-preserved gatehouse. It played a key role in various conflicts, including the sieges of Limerick. Today, it serves as a popular tourist attraction with interactive exhibits showcasing medieval history. Day 3, March 29: Sunday: Dingle.

Today is a free day in Dingle. Suggested activity: Experience the thrill of whale watching in Dingle, Ireland! Set sail on the Atlantic and witness majestic humpback, minke, and even fin whales in their natural habitat. Along the way, enjoy stunning coastal views, playful dolphins, and diverse seabirds. Day 4, March 30: Monday: Dingle- Kinsale.

Today we depart Dingle and make our way to Killarney. Upon arrival, we will take a jaunting cart ride through Killarney National Park. Travel back in time with a traditional Jaunting Car ride through Killarney National Park, heading toward the historic Ross Castle. Take in iconic sights like St. Mary's Cathedral and the Deenagh River as you enjoy your very own private, scenic adventure in one of Ireland's most picturesque regions. Time for lunch in Killarney. We continue to Kinsale. Kinsale is a charming coastal town in County Cork, Ireland, famed for its colorful streets, rich history, and gourmet food scene.

Day 5, March 31: Tuesday: Kinsale

We begin today by heading to Cobh. The Cobh Heritage Centre, located in Cobh, County Cork, Ireland, tells the story of Ireland's emigrant past. Housed in a restored Victorian railway station, it explores Cobh's role as the Titanic's last port of call and its history of emigration, maritime heritage, and convict transportation. We then head to Blarney for some shopping at the woolen mill. Blarney Woolen Mills, located in Blarney, County Cork, Ireland, is a historic woolen mill and one of the country's most famous shopping destinations. Established in 1823, it offers high-quality Irish woolsens, knitwear, and crafts. For those looking to visit Blarney Castle, they can do it on their own. **Evening Session with Kevin.**

Overnight Trident Hotel Kinsale

Day 6, April 1: Wednesday: Kinsale- Galway.

Early morning departure from Kinsale to make the journey to Galway via Doolin. We'll take the Tarbert Ferry and make our way to Doolin. Time for lunch then we'll take the Cliffs of Moher Cruise. Not only will you get stunning views of the cliffs but also enjoy the dramatic scenery and potentially spot wildlife such as seabirds and, occasionally, dolphins or other marine life. Then arrive Bohemian Galway with its brightly painted pubs with live music.

Day 7, April 2: Thursday: Connemara.

After enjoying breakfast, we meet our driver guide in the lobby of the hotel and begin to tour of The Connemara National Park. Connemara, (Conmaicnemara – the tribe of Cormac by the sea), white sandy beaches, dark bogs and tall jagged mountains make this one of the most scenic and unspoiled areas in the country. Wild and rugged, in some places here, Gaelic remains the only spoken language. We travel first to Clifden, (An Clochan). Founded in the early 19th century by John D'Arcy, it retains much of its Georgian architecture. Placed at the head of a broad Atlantic Bay and nestled below the Twelve Bens, the town is blessed by its beautiful setting. **Evening Session with Kevin**

Overnight at the Imperial Hotel Galway.

Day 8, April 3: Friday: Galway- Inn at Dromoland.

Today, you are free to enjoy Galway this morning before an early afternoon departure from Galway. Stroll through the bustling streets of the city center, where you'll find lively pubs, street performers, and unique shops. Visit the medieval Galway Cathedral and explore the Spanish Arch, a historic landmark. Take a walk along the Salthill Promenade for stunning views of Galway Bay. Don't miss the Galway Market for local food, crafts, and entertainment. We then make our way to the Inn at Dromoland. The Inn at Dromoland is a charming, family-friendly hotel located in County Clare, nestled within the scenic Dromoland Castle estate. Surrounded by lush greenery and tranquil gardens, the inn offers a cozy and relaxed atmosphere. Farewell dinner tonight!
